## **Health and Safety Policy – Statement of Intent**

As a provider of fire protection services it is the AFE Fire Protection policy to promote and ensure so far as is reasonably practicable, the health, safety and welfare, at work, of our employees and of others who may be affected by our activities. The company also commits itself to the identification of hazards in all workplaces where it is involved insofar as its operations are concerned and the control of the risks that those hazards present so far as is reasonably practicable.

In order to achieve our policy aims, adequate resources will be made available to safeguard our employees, and any other person who may be affected by our activities, from any reasonably foreseeable hazard to health and safety in new or existing working conditions, equipment and systems of work.

All our employees are expected to be aware of their own responsibilities in respect of health and safety matters and to co-operate fully by taking reasonable care of the health and safety of both themselves and of others who may be affected by their acts and omissions whilst at work. The company will regularly consult employees on relevant safety matters and is committed to continue improvement in health and safety performance.
